This week the program was presented by a representative of Blue Star Energy Solutions. They are representative the city of Aurora in the Go Green Aurora campaign. This effort by the city is to get 2,600 homes and businesses to sign up for alternative energy providers (wind tunnel) by December 8th. Known as the Aurora Green Power Challenge, it is the City of Aurora's campaign to increase renewable energy purchases by households and businesses and qualify as the 1st U>S> Environmental Protection Agency Green Power Community in Illinois.

Green Power is electricity that is generated from environmentally preferable renewable resources such as solar, wind, geothermal, or other low impact hydro rather than from traditional sources such a through the burning of

fossil fuels like coal and oil. Green power purchases also support the development of new renewable energy generation sources nationwide.

By becoming a green power community, and purchasing renewable energy, Aurora will help to conserve our natural resources by reducing our carbon footprint; support the creation of American clean energy jobs and a clean energy economy; and assist in the generation of new renewable energy.
